PRESIDENT'S REPORT: Bill, W8JUY

The history of the Cherryland Amateur Radio Club is a most interesting and varied one from it's early beginnings back in the late 1940's, when such stalwarts as Kirk Kirkby, W8SXQ; Harry Keller, W8ZWM; Bob Durrett, W8SRV; Ralph Bieser, W8ZLK; Ike Hagan, W8GVS; Guyles Dane, W8ALL; Bill Kiker, W8ZTB; Ray Swan, K8QZX; Theron Darrow, W8AZQ, and many, many others, spent many hours promoting the "CARC" and Amateur Radio.

Through the early years of the 1950's, the club grew and prospered. The membership grew to over 50 with members coming regularly from as far away as Scottville, Manistee, Manton, and Rogers City. The attainment of emergency equipment - generator - "that's what the club minutes called it back in 1953"; transmitter and receiver and a quonset hut on the campus of NMC as our own club house, these attest to our progress at that time. Then during the 1960's and early 1970's, a lack of interest and leadership allowed the club to disintergrate, with sporadic attempts to re-establish itself.

Then in 1972, with the help of Bill Missal, WB4FKO/8; Jack Leishman, K8YZW; Edna and John Widman, WB8EYL and WA8BUB; and many other interested Hams, the CARC was again re-activated. The club has again grown and prospered through the leadership of Terry Wolfley, WB8PLQ, Jack Leishman, K8YZW; and Bill Mader, WA8WWN; "sometimes known as Howard".

Our membership has now grown to over 80 members, again serving a large area of Northwest Michigan, and with many activities for all members.

We can be proud of an active history and of our contribution to public service. All of this has been possible only through the involvement of this membership with each doing his own thing in cooperation with others.

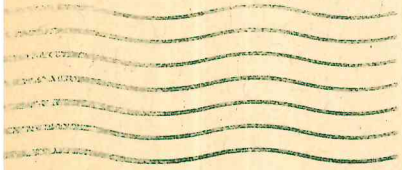
Bill Martinek will be coming in around 14.280 at around 8 a.m. most mornings from his station in Granada.

Don't forget to be at the next meeting for a good program, coffee and cookies etc. 7:30 p.m., Oct. 25.

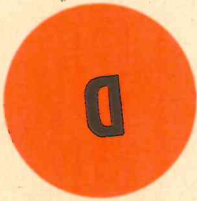

BOARD MEETING was held wed, oct. 5th at the ELKS club. BIG "AL" W8CYO is our REPEATER CHAIRMAN AND YOU'LL BE HEARING MORE FROM HIM. WORK IS UNDER WAY ON GETTING THE NEW REPEATER ON THE AIR, IN THE MEANTIME "BACK AT THE RANCH" JERRY K8YVL HAS THE OLD REPEATER BACK ON THE AIR.

AT THE BOARD MEETING DAVE SPORRY AND GREG NORTON WERE APPOINTED BY PRESIDENT BILL TO BE RESPONSIBLE FOR CLUB ACTIVITIES - THEY WILL NEED YOUR HELP IN THESE PROJECTS.

FOLLOWING IS A REPORT FROM OUR PRESIDENT BILL W8JUY WHO IS NOW BASKING IN THE SUN WHILE HE IS DX'ING ALL US WORKING FOLKS. ....

..... THE HISTORY OF THE CHERRYLAND AMATEUR RADIO CLUB IS A MOST INTERESTING AND VARIED ONE FROM ITS EARLY BEGINNINGS BACK IN THE LATE 1940'S, WHEN SUCH STATUARDS AS KIRK ~~KIRKBY~~ <sup>KIRKBY</sup> W8SYQ; HARRY HELLER W8ZWM; BOB DURNETT W8SRV; RALPH BIESER W8ZLK; IKE HAGAN W8GVS; GUYLES DANE W8ALL; BILL KIKER W8ZTB, RAY SWAN K8QZX, THENON DARNOW W8AZQ AND MANY MANY OTHERS SPENT MANY HOURS PROMOTING THE "CARC" AND AMATEUR RADIO.

THROUGH THE EARLY YEARS OF THE 1950'S THE CLUB GREW AND PROSPERED, THE MEMBERSHIP GREW TO OVER 50 WITH MEMBERS ~~COMING~~ COMING REGULARLY FROM AS FAR AWAY AS SCOTTVILLE, MANISTEE, MANTON, AND ROGENS CITY, THE ATTAINMENT OF EMERGENCY EQUIPMENT - GENERATOR - "THAT'S WHAT THE CLUB MINUTES CALLED IT BACK IN 1953"; TRANSMITTER AND RECEIVER AND A QUONSET HUT ON THE CAMPUS OF NMC AS OUR OWN CLUB HOUSE, THESE ATTEST TO OUR PROGRESS AT THAT TIME. THEN DURING THE 1960'S AND EARLY 1970'S A LACK OF INTEREST AND LEADERSHIP ALLOWED THE CLUB TO DISINTEGRATE, WITH SPORADIC ATTEMPTS TO RE-ESTABLISH ITSELF.

THEN IN 1972, WITH THE HELP OF BILL MISSAL WB4FKO/8, JACK LEISTMAN K8YZW, EDNA AND JOHN WIDMAN WB8EYL AND WA8BUB AND MANY OTHER INTERESTED HAMS THE CARC WAS AGAIN <sup>RE-</sup>ACTIVATED. THE CLUB HAS AGAIN GROWN AND PROSPERED THROUGH THE LEADERSHIP OF TERRY WOLFLEY WB8PLQ, JACK LEISTMAN K8YZW AND BILL MADEN ~~WB8WUN~~ WA8WUN "SOMETIMES KNOWN AS HOWARD".

OUR MEMBERSHIP HAS NOW GROWN TO OVER 80 MEMBERS, AGAIN SERVING A LARGE AREA OF NORTHWEST MICHIGAN, AND WITH MANY ACTIVITIES FOR ALL OUR MEMBERS.

WE CAN BE PROUD OF OUR ACTIVE HISTORY  
AND OUR CONTRIBUTION TO PUBLIC SERVICE.  
ALL OF THIS HAS BEEN POSSIBLE ONLY THROUGH  
THE INVOLVEMENT OF THE MEMBERSHIP WITH  
EACH DOING HIS OWN THING IN COOPERATION  
WITH OTHERS.

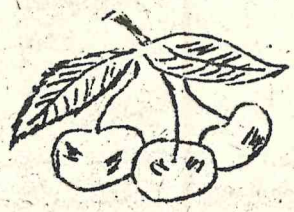
