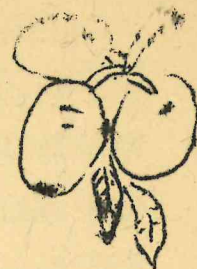

Bring your trailers, tents, and motor homes, as there is plenty of room. We need a lot of you there - we need operators, loggers, setter-uppers, etc., etc. Come early and stay late; John and Jerry will be at the site by 10:00 a.m. Saturday, June 24th; they will need some of you there by then to help get things rolling.
